Squash Tournament Rules

Closing Date for entries: Friday 28th May 2010



Bronze Sanctioned Event

1. Players may enter only one event and must be under the required age on Sunday 13th June 2010.
2. Players must wear eye protection at all times when on court.
3. Players must be England Squash & Racketball members for the current season unless they do not play outside of their county.
4. This competition will feature a main draw and plate competition for 1st round losers. Players must play all scheduled matches. Withdrawal without a valid reason will result in being recorded as a loss on the ranking system. The organiser reserves the right to amend the format or implement round robin and/or A & B draws dependant on entries.
5. Entrants in the Boys U19 and Boys U17 categories **must** be prepared to play on the evening of Friday 11th June (subject to entries)
6. Play will commence at 9.00am on Saturday and the last scheduled matches on court may be as late as 8.00pm.
7. All seeding will be carried out by England Squash & Racketball.
8. The England Squash & Racketball code of conduct and disciplinary procedures will be used for this tournament.
9. Withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to the organiser as soon as possible by telephone with a valid reason. Your reason must then be confirmed in writing to England Squash & Racketball within seven days and in the event of illness or injury, should be accompanied by a medical certificate.
10. First match times will be emailed to all competitors who supply a valid email address and will be published on the England Squash & Racketball website. **Please ensure your email address is clearly legible.** Information will not be sent by post.
11. Competitors must be prepared to mark and referee when requested to do so. The winner of each match is responsible for bringing their result sheet to the tournament desk at the completion of the match.
12. Players must report to the tournament desk 20 minutes before their match.
13. Parents are reminded that they must not interfere in matches but to address any complaints to the tournament desk.
14. All finalists are expected to attend the presentation out of respect for our sponsors. **Those who decide to leave early will be presented with the relevant trophy but will forfeit their prize (if applicable).**
15. Results from this sanctioned event will be forwarded immediately to England Squash & Racketball for ranking purposes.
16. The tournament organisers and the Devon & Exeter Squash & Racketball Club do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage, or injury to competitors or those accompanying them.
17. The tournament organiser's decision on all matters is final.
18. All players become honorary members of the club for the weekend of the tournament. Any misbehaviour will be dealt with severely, on or off court.
