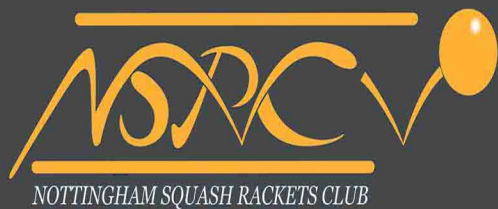

Tournament Rules

Players may enter only one event and must be under the required age on Sunday 28th June 2010

The closing date for entries is Monday 14th June 2010.

Maximum of 64 entry draws.

Players must wear eye protection. These can be purchased from the NSRC club shop through out the tournament weekend.

England Squash membership is compulsory for all players wishing to compete in this sanctioned event (except players who do not compete outside their county of residence)

This tournament will employ the Monrad system, as such all players are required to participate to the events conclusion.

Players finishing in the top 4 of each competition are expected to stay for the sponsor's trophy presentation, which will take place immediately after the last match. Failure to do so will result in loss of prize/money.

Current England Squash disciplinary procedures will be enforced for this tournament. Withdrawal from this tournament must be notified to the organiser as soon as possible by telephone with a valid reason. Your reason for withdrawal including withdrawals from the plate should then be confirmed in writing to England Squash within 7 days and, in the event of illness or injury should be accompanied by a letter of explanation or medical certificate.

All players shall wear clothing suitable for squash.

Players must report to the tournament desk at least 30 minutes before the start of each match. Players must be available to mark matches if requested.

Players will be sent relevant tournament draws and match times, directions to the club and a list of accommodation at least seven days before the start of the tournament.

Parents are asked not to interfere with matches but to report any complaints to the tournament desk.

Results from this event will be forwarded immediately to England Squash and Racketball for ranking and seeding purposes.

The England Squash Code of Conduct shall apply.

The Tournament Organisers' decisions on all matters are final.
